## WATERCOLOR SUPPLIES

### Materials Needed

Watercolor paper, preferably Strathmore, Arches or paper with 100% cotton content. (Some rice papers are good for watercolor painting)

6 or more brushes number 2, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14. Calligraphy brushes can be used for watercolor painting

Set of basic watercolor paints, no more than 12

Trays or styrofoam plates for mixing colors

Drawing pencils "B"

Soft eraser

One or two pint size plastic containers for water

Paper towels

### Basic watercolor paint set:

Paints come in tubes of different sizes, one ounce and up. They can be found at UH Bookstore, Hawaiian Graphics on Beretania, Fishers in Kakaako or in China Town. Lesser quality watercolor paints can be found at Walmart, Ross and Ben Franklin. They also carry brushes and watercolor papers. Thank you.
