

2024 Hongwanji Spring Bazaar: Essential Info

Hours: 8:30 a.m. – 1 p.m. (sales of scrip start at 8 a.m. at the scrip tent in front of the temple).

Buy Scrip First: Scrip is required for most purchases. Buy strips of \$0.50 tickets at the scrip tent or at the rummage sale, clothing sale, or in the Annex Hall. Exception: the Craft Fair vendors handle their own payments in cash, credit, etc. — you can shop there without scrip.

1 scrip = \$0.50

- 4 scr. soda/juice
- 10 scr. waffle dog
- 12 scr. fried noodle
- 10 scr. assorted manju
- 1 scr. mug (rummage)
- 2-3 scr. fabric pieces
