Rev. Shigenori Makino was born in Kitakyushu, Fukuoka, Japan.

He studied Jōdo Shinshū Buddhism at Ryukoku University, where he earned both his bachelor's and master's degrees. He later earned a Master of Science degree in psychology from Winona State University.

Rev. Makino has served at several Hongwanji temples in Japan, Hawaii, and Canada, including Sapporo Betsuin, Wailuku Hongwanji, Kailua Hongwanji, Moiliili Hongwanji, Hawaii Betsuin as Rimban, and Toronto Buddhist Church. He also supported the establishment of the Project Dana program.

He has also received training in pastoral care and has served as a counselor and chaplain in various communities.
